The school's native bush food garden and Culture Yarns program provides valuable opportunities for the entire school to learn about and connect with Aboriginal culture and hear from local cultural figures.

The garden is home to a statue of the Awabakal people's totem, the eagle. Principal, Cheryl Henderson, and Aboriginal Education Teacher, Belinda Huntriss, boast that Lawson is an extraordinary young man, how his culture is so important to him, that he shares his knowledge in such a powerful way and that he is a really good yidaki player.
