3387 - BREAST SCREENING

Ms SONIA HORNERY (Wallsend):

That this House:

(1) Notes that the number of New South Wales breast screens dropped by 22 per cent in 2021 compared to 2019.

(2) Notes that breast screening is essential for early detection and diagnosis of breast cancer and extremely important for women's health.

(3) Calls on the Minister for Health to ensure breast screen services increase staff numbers to cope with increased demand.
