That this House:

- (1) Notes that the number of New South Wales breast screens dropped by 22 per cent in 2021 compared to 2019.
- (2) Notes that breast screening is essential for early detection and diagnosis of breast cancer and extremely important for women's health.
- (3) Calls on the Minister for Health to ensure breast screen services increase staff numbers to cope with increased demand.
