1991 - ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE

Ms SONIA HORNERY (Wallsend):

That this House:

Consider the sale of power generation and delivery infrastructure compromises the stability and affordability of energy across New South Wales.

Notes that AGL's plan to close Liddell and Bayswater stations between 2022 and 2032 will only further jeopardise the energy economy of which Wallsend is a part.

Calls on the Government to implement an approach to energy infrastructure including renewable and sustainable energy technologies, which serves the interest of the public, not private operators.
