1761 - RAIL ROLLING STOCK CONTRACT

That this House:

Notes that hundreds of jobs at Downer EDI in Cardiff will be lost as a result of the Government's decision to award the contract for new rolling stock to a company which will manufacture them overseas.

Notes the problems that Queensland Rail's overseas built train carriages have had including faulty brakes and air-conditioning, poor ventilation, inadequate driver visibility and poor disability access.

Calls on the Minister for Transport to support local workers by designing and building new trains in New South Wales.
