ALZHEIMER'S AND DEMENTIA

Ms SONIA HORNERY (Wallsend):

Notes the a report commissioned by Alzheimer's Australia revealed that the number of people estimated to be living with dementia in Australia has risen to more than 413,000 with more than 291,000 people providing care either in the community or in cared accommodation.

Notes that by 2056, the number of Australians living with dementia is expected to be 1,100,000 and their carers could number 776,000.

Commends the work of Alzheimer's Australia in providing services to those affected by dementia, their families and carers.

Calls on the Minister for Health to do more to help Alzheimer's Australia and people affected by dementia.
